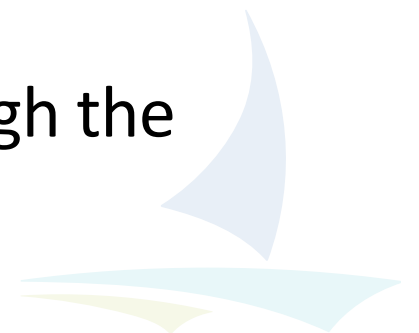
# Executive Mayor – Legislative Council

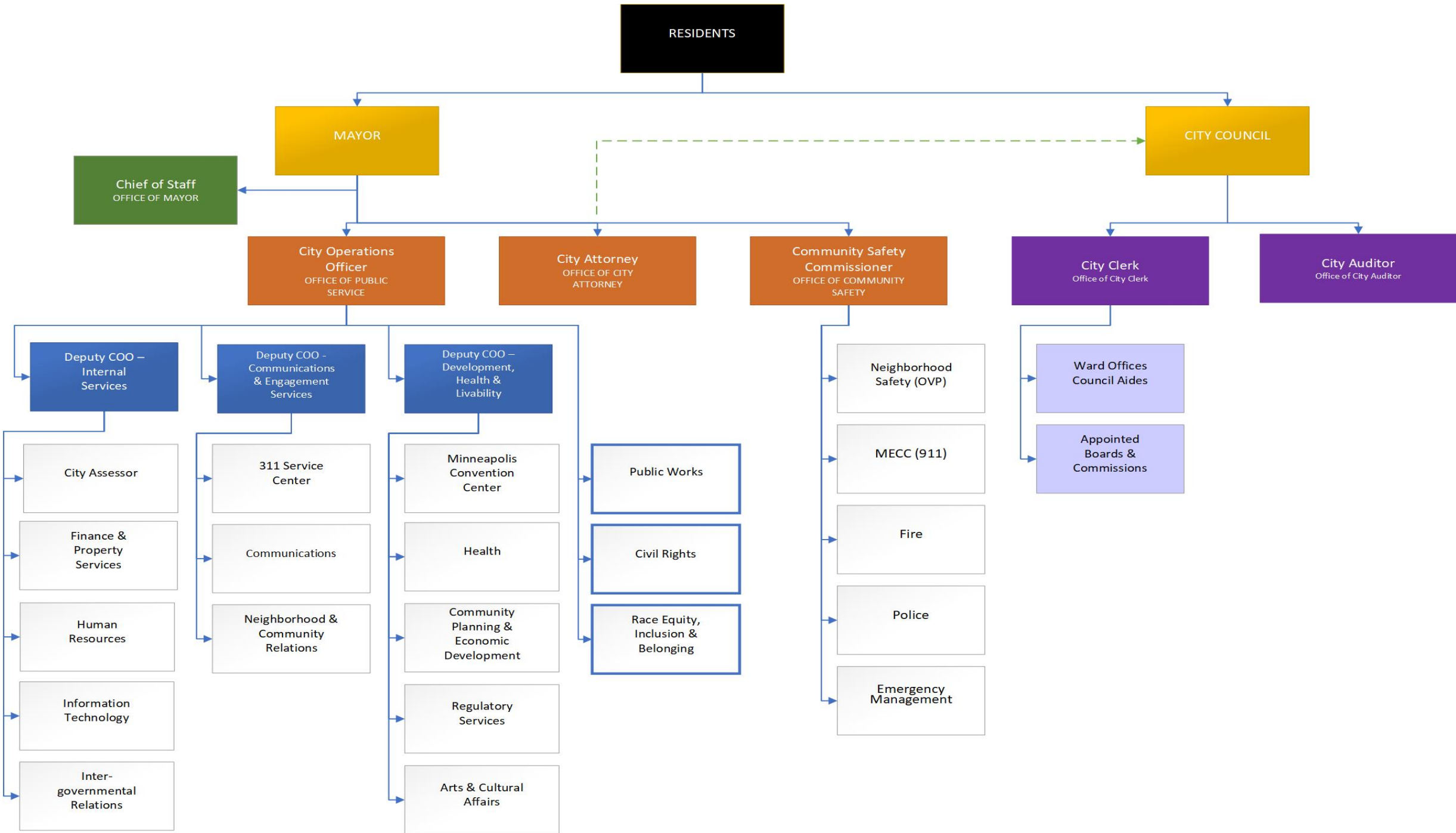
Approved by voters in 2021 – Charter Amendment No. 184.

- City Council is the City’s legislative body with policymaking, oversight, and representational functions.
- Mayor is the City’s chief executive officer with direct authority over the City’ Administration (departments and operations).

Mayor has proposed an operating structure aimed at achieving an efficient design and provides effective service delivery in a manner that is equitable to all residents.

Council has authority to determine organizational design through the creation of departments (by ordinance).

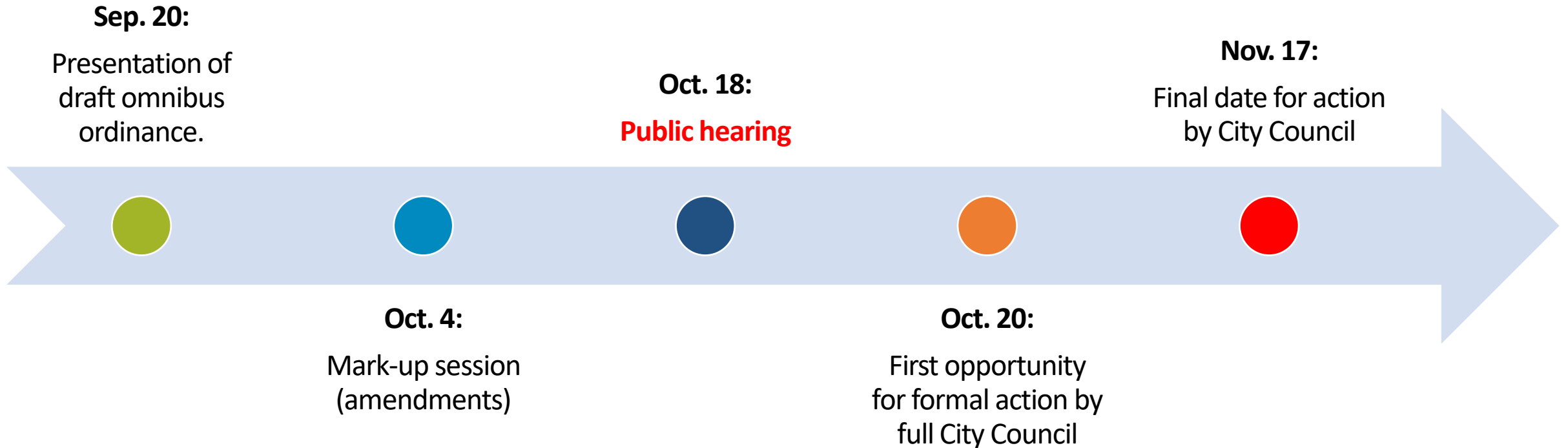

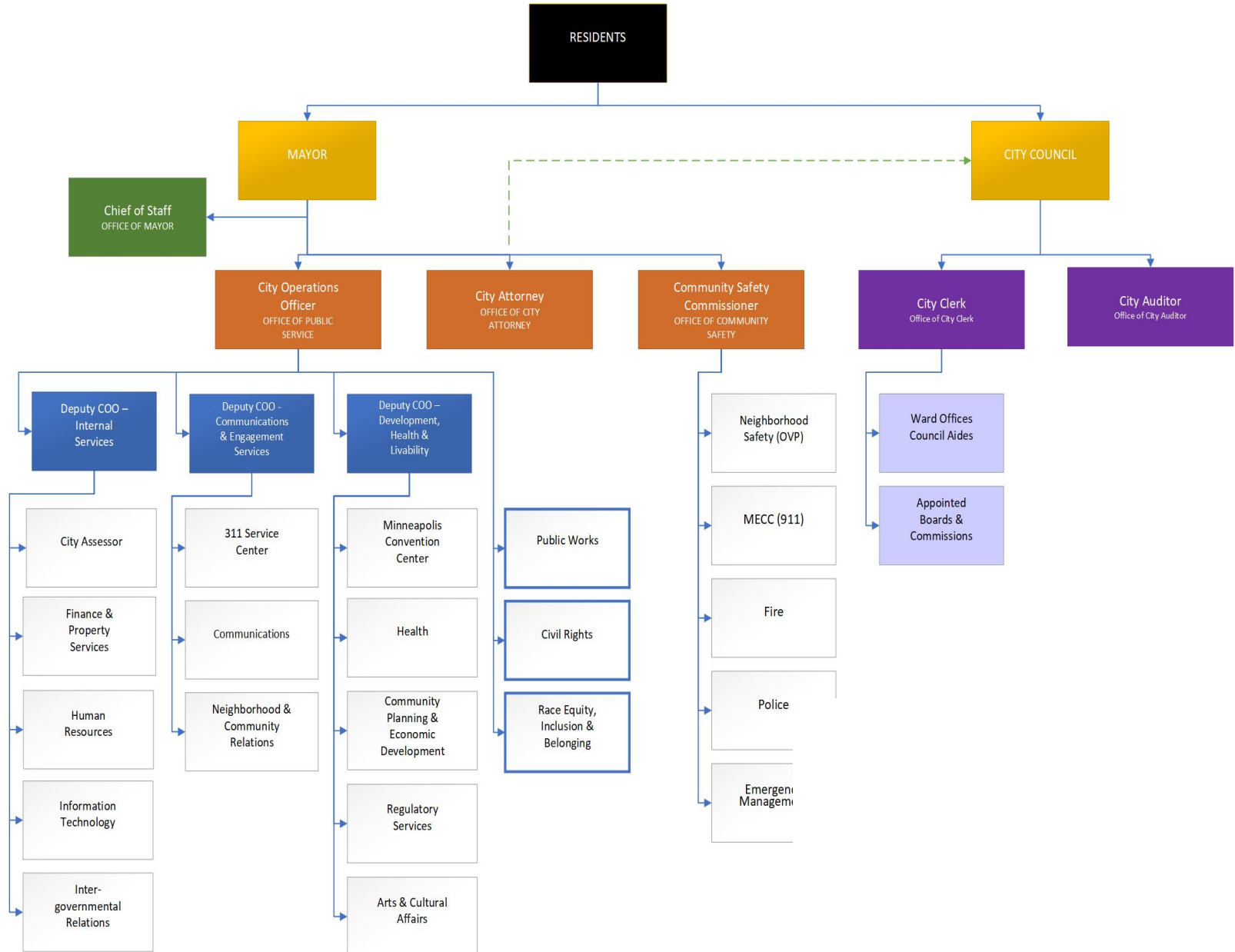
