**RESOLUTION**  
**By Koski and Osman**

Whereas, the Mayor, the City Council, and City Staff have shared interest in advancing the work of developing and providing a broad range of community safety strategies; and

Whereas, the Mayor, the City Council, and City Staff are fully committed to building out a spectrum of community safety services that meet the unique needs of residents across the city; and

Whereas, the Mayor, the City Council, and City Staff agree that the development of a Community Safety Center/3<sup>rd</sup> Precinct is paramount in advancing community safety work; and

Whereas, the Mayor, the City Council, and City Staff have shared interest in proceeding with the most consensus-oriented, cost effective, time effective option for the development of a Community Safety Center/3<sup>rd</sup> Precinct; and

Whereas, the Mayor, the City Council, and City Staff have shared interest in proceeding in a manner that is consensus-oriented, transparent, accountable, efficient, effective, equitable, and inclusive; and

Whereas, the Mayor, the City Council, and City Staff have shared interest in expressing their commitments regarding a Community Safety Center/3<sup>rd</sup> Precinct in a manner which is formal, clear, concise, and available to the public;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by The City Council of The City of Minneapolis:

That the City expresses our commitment:

1. To the development of a Community Safety Center/3<sup>rd</sup> Precinct at 2633 Minnehaha Ave, Minneapolis, MN 55406, which will include both Community Safety functions, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Precinct functions, and
2. That this Community Safety Center/3<sup>rd</sup> Precinct will serve as a reflection of the City's Community Safety mission, vision, and values, and as a reflection of the City's robust, comprehensive Community Safety ecosystem, and
3. To inform and involve the community in further development of the Community Safety Center/3<sup>rd</sup> Precinct's mission, vision, values, and design, and
4. To ensure that the development of both the Community Safety Center facility components, and the 3<sup>rd</sup> Precinct facility components are completed in a cost effective, time effective manner, and
5. To host the ceremonial Grand Opening of the Community Safety Center/3<sup>rd</sup> Precinct when the Community Safety Center/3<sup>rd</sup> Precinct is complete in its entirety, which includes the development of both the Community Safety Center facility components, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Precinct facility components.
