Approving and extending the Mayor's Declaration of Local Emergency resulting from the civil disturbance and threat to public health, safety, and welfare in the aftermath of the death of George Perry Floyd.

Whereas, in the evening hours of Monday, May 25, 2020, George Perry Floyd died after being detained by and while in the custody of officers of the Minneapolis Police Department; and

Whereas, Mr. Floyd's untimely death while in the custody of police officers has sparked protest and civil unrest that have resulted in disturbances over the course of multiple days and nights, primarily in the City's 3rd Police Precinct and its surrounding neighborhoods, which has led to at least one death as well as significant injuries to multiple individuals, the destruction of property, the looting of area businesses, and similar actions, the scale of which exceeds the capacity and resources of the City to address effectively; and

Whereas, on May 28, 2020, Mayor Frey formally requested the Governor of the State of Minnesota to provide any available assistance and support, including support from the Minnesota National Guard, to aid the City in its efforts to protect the health, safety, and general welfare of the community and to restore order and peace, to which the Governor did respond through his Executive Order 20-64; and

Whereas, pursuant to the provisions set forth in Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 12.29, and the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances, Section 128.50, Mayor Frey declared a state of local emergency within the City of Minneapolis on Thursday, May 28, 2020, to be and remain in force and effect beginning that date and continuing for a period of seventy-two (72) hours, pending ratification of the City Council, as required by law; and

Whereas, during the declared state of local emergency, Mayor Frey proclaimed Emergency Regulation No. 2020-2-1, imposing a mandated nighttime curfew within the City of Minneapolis in all public places, including streets, from 8:00 p.m. on Friday, May 29, 2020, until 6:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 30, 2020, and again from 8 p.m. on Saturday, May 30, 2020, until 6:00 a.m. on Sunday, May 31, 2020;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by The City Council of The City of Minneapolis:

That in accordance with Section 128.50 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances (Declaration of Emergency), the City Council does hereby ratify the state of local emergency proclaimed by Mayor Frey on Thursday, March 28, 2020, pertaining to the City of Minneapolis and all its residents.

That the declared state of local emergency shall continue and does hereby remain in force and in effect through June 12, 2020, or until such time as the City Council, by official action, may further extend or terminate the declared state of local emergency for the City of Minneapolis.

That pursuant to Minneapolis Code of Ordinances, Section 128.80, the Mayor's Emergency Regulations No. 2020-2-1 is hereby ratified and shall be extended throughout the duration of the declared state of local emergency, until such time as they may be renewed by further action of the Mayor, or until such time as the City Council, by official action, may further extend or terminate said emergency regulations.

Be It Further Resolved that the City Council hereby directs the City Clerk to publish and post this resolution ratifying the declared state of local emergency in the City of Minneapolis, including posting on the City's website and official bulletin boards.
