The Minneapolis City Council hereby directs that the Minneapolis Police Department (MPD) will report quarterly to the Public Safety, Civil Rights and Emergency Management Committee regarding the operation of Body Worn Cameras on MPD staff. The reports of the Minneapolis Police Department will include:

1. How often (total number and %) are body cameras not being turned on when dispatch data indicates they should?
2. Have there been any changes to the body camera policy? Are there any changes being considered?
3. Who is in charge of the ongoing effectiveness of the body camera program?
4. What are the emerging themes of the reviewed data, and what issues are being identified by supervisors?

These reports will commence in the first quarter of 2018 and continue thereafter.
