

Legislative Directive

Pursuant to City Charter Section 7.1(h)(1)(B), the Minneapolis City Council requests a nonpartisan, multidisciplinary review from the Mayor of the following:

1. A comprehensive fiscal analysis of the potential costs and impacts of the settlement agreement between the City of Minneapolis and the Minnesota Department of Human Rights.
2. An analysis on the budgeting and costs that other cities have incurred during the duration of a consent decree.
3. An overview of how budget forecasting for settlement agreement compliance will be prioritized in the Minneapolis Police Department (MPD)'s budget for 2024 and 2025 including the role of the independent evaluator.
4. Recommendations on how MPD's current operating budget can be adjusted to increase success factors related to settlement agreement compliance.
5. An updated full-time employee (FTE) count on MPD officers who are on active duty and regularly scheduled to work, number of officers who are out on leave, anticipated recruits in 2023, and expected retirees in 2023, 2024, and 2025.
6. Fiscal information related to cross-jurisdictional resources MPD receives from other law enforcement agencies, in the years 2018-2022.

Present the requested information, including any proposed changes or policy implementations, along with a fiscal analysis of any recommendations to the Committee of the Whole's Pattern & Practice Investigations Subcommittee, no later than June 26, 2023.
