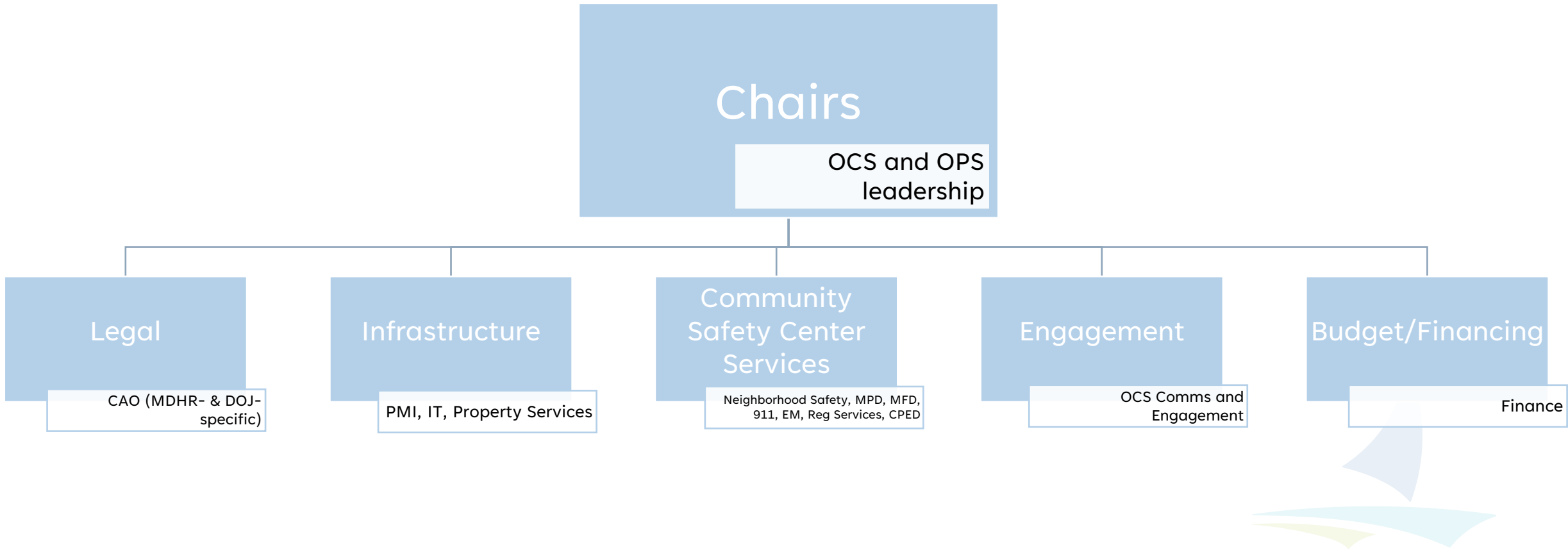
# THE NEED

- Requires a credible partner aligned with our approach and proven expertise in the assessment and co-design of alternative public safety responses

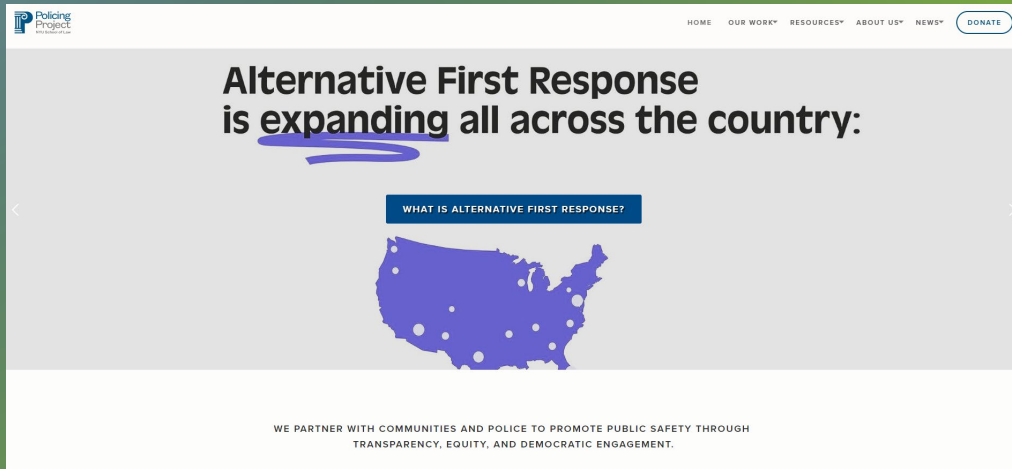

- Has been conducting in-depth, on-the-ground research on alternative response across the country, working with community members and municipal stakeholders—police officers and leadership, alternative responders, 911 operators, City Hall staff, and others
- Engaged in an expansive effort to learn about and support jurisdictions redesigning public safety systems.
- Uniquely positioned to support the realignment of public safety services in Minneapolis to address underlying community needs and reduce reliance on police.
- Constructed a team, community of thought leaders and practitioners nationwide.
- Their work in Minneapolis will include the engagement of the Safe and Thriving Communities report co-author Dr. Antonio Oftelie.

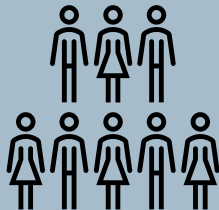
## Research
