- Request a free Pop-up testing event for your company/organization
- Order free COVID test kits to be delivered to your home/business

- COVID 19 Saliva Test kits
 - Cannot eat, drink or use tobacco products for 30 minutes before taking the test.
 - Requires internet access (via smart phone or computer)
 - Create an online account with Vault Labs
 - Results received via email within 24-72 hours after the test (home test results take longer)

Free COVID-19 Saliva Testing

Free saliva testing hosted by the Minneapolis Health Department

You will usually receive your results in about 24 hours.

Do not eat, drink, or use tobacco products for 30 minutes before taking a COVID-19 saliva test.

- Airport testing site is open 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. seven days a week.

Take a saliva test at home

Anyone in Minnesota can order a saliva test to be delivered to their home with rush shipping. Once your test is received at the lab, you will receive your results in 24-48 hours.
