Public Case Synopses March – 2021

	Outcome	Description
1	Closed – Coaching	<p>10-401.1 - Property and Evidence Acquired Or Temporarily Stored At Precincts 5-105 (B)(4) - Professional Code of Conduct</p> <p>It is alleged that an officer tossed the complainant’s belongings in the trash after the complainant was arrested. It is also alleged that officers on the scene did not wear the necessary PPE required by MPD.</p>
2	Closed – Dismissed	<p>MPD P&P § 5-104.01 Professional Policing MPD P&P § 4-602 Report Writing</p> <p>It is alleged that officers failed to provide a police report and complainant was told to leave the scene.</p>
3	Closed – Dismissed	<p>MPD P&P § 7-402 Pursuit Policy</p> <p>It is alleged that several squads were involved in a pursuit spanning several PCTs, neighboring cities, and two MPD officers that were injured.</p>
4	Closed – Dismissed	<p>5-104.01 - Professional Policing 4-602 - Report Writing</p> <p>It is alleged that officers failed to provide a police</p>

		report and complainant was told to leave the scene without a case number.
5	Closed - Coaching	MPD P&P § 5-105 Professional Code of Conduct It is alleged that an officer added inappropriate comments in their PIMS supplement.
6	Closed - Coaching	MPD P&P § 7-402 (IV)(B)(2)(a) – Pursuit Policy It is alleged that officers were travelling through a green traffic light when a vehicle driving perpendicular to them ran a red light. Officers followed the vehicle in order to initiate a traffic stop. The vehicle did slow before fleeing from officers, resulting in a pursuit being initiated. The pursuit was quickly terminated.
7	Closed – Dismissed	4-402 Vehicle Idling It is alleged that officers knowingly blocked a public roadway with their squad without the squad’s lights and sirens activated.
8	Closed – Dismissed	5-104.01 - Professional Policing It is alleged that an officer was rude and dismissive towards the complainant who called to report a crime against their partner.
9		7-402 (IV)(A)(3) – Pursuit Policy

	Closed – Dismissed	<p>It is alleged that officers attempted to stop a suspected stolen vehicle. Initially, the driver slowed and appeared to stop, however, when officers exited their vehicle and gave the command for the driver to show their hands, the driver fled the scene. Officers continued to follow with lights activated and observed the driver operating the vehicle in an erratic manner. A pursuit was initiated, reaching speeds of about 55 mph, before being terminated after a duration of approximately 25 seconds.</p>
10	Closed - Coaching	<p>4-410 – City Vehicles and On-Duty Accidents</p> <p>It is alleged that an officer driving an unmarked MPD vehicle struck a City-owned, unoccupied vehicle while backing out of a parking spot. There was minimal damage observed on the back bumper of the unmarked car, as well as minimal damage to the side door of the other City-owned vehicle.</p>
